Competition Team Participation Agreement

Effective Date: 2/28/26

As The Warehouse Dance Company continues to grow, we are formalizing expectations for all competition team members to ensure clarity, consistency, and professionalism across our program. Competition team participation is a higher level commitment than recreational enrollment and requires adherence to the standards outlined below.

1. Mandatory Attendance

Competition team members are expected to attend all required:

- Competitions
- Conventions
- Team rehearsals
- Performances
- Studio-scheduled appearances

Because choreography, spacing, and team formations depend on full participation, failure to attend a required event may result in reevaluation of routine placement or team status at the sole discretion of studio leadership.

2. Parental Responsibility & Custody Matters

The Warehouse Dance Company does not participate in or mediate custody disputes.

All legal guardians are responsible for coordinating schedules to ensure the dancer fulfills required team obligations. Custody arrangements, parental disagreements, or personal conflicts do not modify attendance requirements or financial commitments.

Failure to attend required events due to custody conflicts may impact team placement decisions.

3. Financial Responsibility

All competition-related fees, including but not limited to entry fees, convention fees, costumes, travel, and associated expenses, remain the responsibility of the account holder as outlined in The Warehouse Dance Company Payment Policy.

Missed events do not waive financial obligations.

4. Studio Discretion

The Warehouse Dance Company reserves the right to make final decisions regarding:

- Team placement
- Routine participation
- Eligibility for performances
- Continued competition team membership

All decisions are made in the best interest of the dancer, the team, and the integrity of the program.

5. Parent Conduct & Professional Boundaries

The Warehouse Dance Company maintains a zero-tolerance policy for harassment, intimidation, or threatening behavior toward staff, instructors, or ownership.

Any parent or guardian who engages in hostile conduct, attempts to coerce policy changes, or uses threats of litigation as leverage may be subject to dismissal from the competition program at the discretion of studio leadership.
